NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Entries close 6:30pm Saturday, April 24, 2010 at the Test Secretary's home.

**Entry fees: Tracking Test - \$55.00 (includes AKC recording fee)
Tracking Excellent Dog Test - \$100.00 (includes AKC recording fee)
(AKC recording fee is \$3.50 per entry/\$3.00 per additional dog)**

Entries will not be accepted without fees or certification.*

- With the entry form for a dog that has not "passed" an AKC Tracking Test, there must be filed an original statement, dated within one year, signed by a person who has been approved by the AKC to judge a Tracking Test, certifying that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test.

Mail all entries and certifications to: Theresa McDanel, Test Secretary, 4667 Petra Mill Rd, Granite Falls, NC 28630. Make all checks payable to the Border Club of America, Inc. Please provide separate forms of payment for each dog entered in the test if you are entering multiple dogs.

Entries will only be accepted via US MAIL (No alternate carriers such as Airbourne, Fedex or UPS, etc) **ALL ENTRIES RECEIVED NON-US MAIL WILL BE RETURNED.**

Entries will be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached, and a drawing will be held to determine which entries will participate in the Tracking Test or Tracking Dog Excellent Test.

Entries will be drawn at the Test Secretary's home at 6:30pm on Wednesday April 28, 2010. Any interested persons may attend. The drawing shall be completely random among all entries received, except that preference shall be given to those dogs that have not previously earned a Tracking Test title (or TDX title if entering TDX) and are Border Terriers. Both TD and TDX test slots will open to all breeds if not filled by Border Terriers. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preference set forth, shall be assigned a position on an Alternate List corresponding to the order in which they were drawn.

If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limit for entries is exceeded in the other test, we will increase the limit of the appropriate test based on available fields.
(Tracking Regulations, 10/1/2000, Chapter 1, Section 12)

Results of the drawing for entries: Entrants will be contacted by email and/or telephone between the hours of 7:00pm and 9:00pm EDT on Wednesday April 28, 2010, advising them of the results. Alternates will be given the opportunity to accept or decline the alternate position. All those submitting entries are requested to be personally available (or provide a designated agent) to receive this notification.

Errors on entry blanks: Owners are responsible for errors in making out forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date.

Unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of / or attached to the Official AKC Forms are not acceptable.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted after the entries have been closed.

No refund of entry fees after the entries close and drawing of tracks except:

- 1) Fee (less \$3.50 for AKC recording fee) of drawn entrant who notifies the Test Secretary of withdrawal prior to test date, provided an alternate is available to fill the vacancy.
- 2) Full refund of alternate entry fee if alternate does not participate.
Refund will be made within 7 days of event.

Bitches in season may participate. Please notify the Test Secretary and Judges prior to the drawing for the tracks. The last track(s) to be laid shall be reserved for the bitch(es) in season. Parking space will be provided away from the general tracking area to minimize any disturbance to any male dogs entered in the test.

A judging program including complete directions to the test site will be mailed to entrants and alternates following the drawing for the entries.

Handlers should assemble at the Nature Center (Main Office) across the road from the Main Show site, FENCE, 3381 Hunting Country Road, Tryon, NC 28782, at 8:30 AM for the drawing for tracks. The first track will be run following the draw.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The use of FLEXI-LEADS within show precincts is prohibited. Show precincts are within 50 Feet of the ring perimeter.
The Border Terrier Club of America, Inc., and their Superintendent assume no responsibility for a wrong entry. Exhibitors are advised to print all unusual words when filling in entry forms
When making a class change for a previously entered dog, send a note before entry closing date, not another entry form. Sweepstakes entries must be on the same entry for used for a regular class.
Only regular AKC titles can be printed in the show catalog-this does NOT include CGC.
Remember, the following non-regular conformation classes are held after Best of Breed, Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace, Team and Best Otter Head. To be eligible for Best Otter Head, dogs must be entered in a BTCA Conformation or Performance specialty event.
The Border Terrier Club of America, Inc. will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it is understood that the Club will not be responsible for loss.
Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs, both at the show site and their hotel. **SEE BTCA ROOM RESPONSIBILITY POLICY.**



BORDER TERRIER CLUB OF AMERICA, INC. ROOM RESPONSIBILITY POLICY

The Border Terrier Club of America, Inc., has adopted the following rules in order to insure that its members and their dogs will be welcome at hotels in the future. Any individual attending a BTCA sanctioned event and staying in a hotel, motel, inn or campsite/fairground has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. This includes picking up after dog(s) on the grounds. Anyone who damages a room or campsite/fairground and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite/fairground management, and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be subject to any or all of the following actions by the BTCA Board of Directors.

- 1. May be banned from showing at the next BTCA sanctioned event(s).
- 2. May be subject to AKC sanctions.
- 3. Membership in the BTCA may be terminated and may not be allowed to be reinstated.

Damages shall be defined as:

- 1. Flea infestation, urine, defecation and/or any damage to hotel/campsite/fairground property (walls, bedspreads, carpets, drapes, etc.)
- 2. Any verified complaint by the host hotel/campsite/fairground.
- 3. Any verified complaint by a BTCA member.

BTCA ROOM REGULATIONS:

- 1. All dogs shall be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner/handler must stay in the room with the dog.
- 2. Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel/campsite/fairground management, and to assume complete financial responsibility for those damages.
- 3. Dogs are to be allowed on hotel furniture/bed ONLY if the furniture is covered with protective covering provided by the owner/handler.
- 4. All owners/handlers will take preventative measures to assure that their dogs are free of fleas, mites, intestinal parasites and other communicable diseases prior to arriving at the hotel/campsite.

THIS POLICY WILL BE INCLUDED IN THE SPECIALTY GUIDELINES AND INCLUDED IN THE PREMIUM LIST WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THAT SIGNING THE ENTRY FORM ALSO INSURES COMPLIANCE WITH THIS POLICY. THIS POLICY WILL ALSO BE INCLUDED IN THE SPECIALTY PACKET MAILED TO MEMBERS AND WILL BE DISTRIBUTED WITH SPECIALTY HOSPITALITY PACKETS. ALL INDIVIDUALS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLY.
